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

**INFORMATIONAL REPORT ON DELEGATED ALLOCATIONS FOR  
TRAFFIC CONGESTION RELIEF (TCR) PROGRAM PROJECTS**

Government Code (GC) Section 14556.5(a) authorizes the California Department of Transportation (Department) to allocate funds from the Traffic Congestion Relief (TCR) Fund, as directed by the California Transportation Commission (Commission), for specific projects, or phases of a project, listed under GC Section 14556.40.

Between June 28 and July 31, 2002, the Department allocated TCR funds totaling \$50,458,000 for eight projects (see project list), or phases of a project, programmed in the TCR Program. Additionally, a STIP allocation for Project #54.1 was made on July 16, 2002, in the amount of \$18,966,011. All projects were included in the "6-Month Allocation List" adopted by the Commission in Resolution G-02-10, and the allocations made are within the limits indicated therein for each project.

Through July 31, 2002, a total of \$3,648,376,000 TCR funds for 141 projects have been approved and the Department or the Commission has allocated \$1,459,583,000 of that amount. The following graph summarizes this information:
