**DELEGATION OF ALLOCATION AUTHORITY**  
**LOCAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCATIONS FOR RIDESHARE PROJECTS**  
**RESOLUTION G-01-07 ALLOCATIONS**

**BACKGROUND**

On February 22, 2001, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) delegated to the Department of Transportation (Department) authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-01-07 for Rideshare projects programmed in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). In addition, the Commission delegated to the Department authority to advance the allocation by two years with the approval of the responsible regional agency. This authority allows the local agencies to begin work without waiting for the next Commission meeting to receive an allocation.

These Rideshare projects are included in the adopted STIP. The Department reports allocations on a monthly basis consistent with Resolution G-01-07.

**SUMMARY**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-01-07, since the last report the Department made one allocation, totaling \$719,000 for one Rideshare project. None of these allocations were made subject to the provisions of AB 872, with reimbursement effective dates up to 12 months prior to the allocation dates.

The allocation of \$719,000 was made for a project programmed in Fiscal Year (FY) 2001-2002. Pursuant to the authority for advancing the allocation by two years, there were no allocations made for project components scheduled for implementation in FY 2002-2003 or 2003-2004. The attached list provides details of the allocation.

As of this report, \$1,004,000 has been allocated this fiscal year. The entire amount is for projects programmed in FY 2001-2002. There have been no advanced allocations from FY 2002-2003 or 2003-2004.
