STIP AMENDMENT FOR ACTION

ACTION UPDATE FROM NOTICE

The Commission requested that amendments noticed for new programming at the May, June, July, and August 2002 Commission meetings be brought forward for action in October to compete for the remaining available State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) programming capacity. The following STIP amendments were noticed at the May, June, July, and August 2002 Commission meetings. Some of the amendments have been updated from the notice and the changes are indicated in the action update. The attached spreadsheet shows the fiscal year and component in which the funds are being requested.

SUMMARY

This item is presenting twenty-four STIP Amendments for action, programming \$161,569,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) and Interregional Improvement Program (IIP) funds across all FY's of the STIP.

02S-023	<p>Action Update: This item was noticed at the August 2002 Commission meeting.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$2,180,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds from Contra Costa County's Unprogrammed Share Balance for three pedestrian and bicycle projects in FY 2006-07: \$1,436,000 for Pleasant Hill Road Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements; \$450,000 for Richmond, Walnut Creek and Pleasant Hill BART Station Bicycle Pavilions; and \$294,000 for Camino Tassajara Road Shoulder Improvements for Bikes.</p>
02S-024	<p>Action Update: This item was noticed at the August 2002 Commission meeting. SLOCOG has withdrawn its request to delay/delete two existing bus projects in FY 2002-03.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$560,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds from FY 2002-03 to FY 2006-07 for two existing bus projects, and reprograms programs \$400,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds FY 2003-04 from San Luis Obispo County's Unprogrammed Share Balance for a Median Barrier Enhancement Project in San Luis Obispo County in FY 2003-04. In addition, this amendment revises the limits of two existing projects (PPNO 0032 and PPNO 0970) in San Luis Obispo County, with no change in funding.</p>

02S-026	<p>Action Update: This item was noticed at the August 2002 Commission meeting.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$1,400,000 in FY 2004-05 for Advance Project Development Element (APDE) as an advance from Monterey County Share towards a \$16,430,000 Route 1 improvement project in the City of Seaside and Sand City.</p>
02S-027	<p>Action Update: This item was noticed at the August 2002 Commission meeting.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$467,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds from Sierra County's Unprogrammed Share Balance for four bridge construction projects in FYs 2003-04, 2005-06, and 2006-07: \$153,000 towards a \$763,000 project to replace the existing Plumbago Road Bridge at Kanaka Creek; \$78,000 towards a \$390,000 project to replace the existing Port Wine Ridge Road Bridge at Cedar Grove Ravine; \$73,000 towards a \$362,000 project to replace the existing Port Wine Ridge Road Bridge at Rock Creek Tributary; and \$163,000 towards a \$817,000 project to replace the Old Fiberboard Road Bridge at Little Truckee River.</p>

Sierra County deleted four projects and for the two remaining projects they delayed the FY in which funds PS&E and Construction were requested.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$4,730,000 \$1,605,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds from Sierra County's Unprogrammed Share Balance towards six two roadway rehabilitation projects in FYs 2003-04, and 2005-06, and 2006-07: \$625,000 for a roadway rehabilitation project on Mountain House Road; \$1,430,000 for a roadway rehabilitation project on County Road A23 Westside Road from Route 49 to Calpine Road; \$715,000 for a roadway rehabilitation project on County Road A23 Westside road from Calpine Road to the Plumas County Line; \$675,000 for a roadway rehabilitation project on County Road A24; \$980,000 for a roadway rehabilitation project on Pike City Road; and \$305,000 for a roadway rehabilitation project on Hill Street.</p>

HCAOG chose this action with the knowledge that it would effectively increase programming capacity in the STIP for which they ask consideration in programming \$61,000 of FY 2002-03 RIP Construction funds. This project is HCAOG's first partnering project with Native Americans living in their region and therefore is of a high importance.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$61,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds from Humboldt County's Unprogrammed Share Balance in FY 2002-03 for the acquisition of one (1) seven-passenger minivan, and one (1) fifteen-passenger bus to provide transportation service for the Bear River Band of Rohnerville Rancheria Community. In addition, this amendment reprograms \$4,100,000 of existing Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funding from FY 2001-02 to FY 2006-07 to partially fund construction of the Route 132 Expressway (PPNO 0944M) in Stanislaus County to accommodate cash flow needs for both projects.</p>

02S-007	<p>Action Update: This item was noticed at the June 2002 Commission meeting. The summary was modified to indicate the correct scope.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$4,013,000 from Lake County's Unprogrammed Share Balance for five new local road rehabilitation, and reconstruction, and bikeway and bridge construction projects: \$839,000 in FY 2002-03, \$182,000 in FY 2003-04, \$1,709,000 in FY 2004-05, and \$1,283,000 in FY 2005-06.</p>
02S-008B	<p>Action Update: This item was noticed at the June 2002 California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting under State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment 02S-008. STIP Amendment 02S-008 had proposed to program \$3,935,000 from Tehama County's Unprogrammed Share Balance for twenty-three projects. The Commission indicated that Tehama County would need to either unprogram existing projects in order to provide programming capacity in the early years of the STIP (FY 2002-03) for any new projects or bring amendment requests for new programming back in October 2002 to compete statewide for available programming capacity.</p> <p>In order to program one new project with a trade to be amended into the STIP, the Department has split STIP Amendment 02S-008 into two separate amendments: STIP Amendment 02S-008A was approved for one project requesting new programming with a trade, and STIP Amendment 02S-008B is for the remaining twenty-two projects.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$3,935,000 \$3,899,000 from Tehama County's Unprogrammed Share balance for twenty-three twenty-two local road rehabilitation and reconstruction, local bridge construction, replacement and rehabilitation, and local bikeway projects: \$36,000 in FY 2002-03; \$235,000 in FY 2004-05; \$3,219,000 in in FY 2005-06; and \$445,000 in FY 2006-07.</p>

The source of the programming changed from Unprogrammed Share Balance to an advance.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$1,325,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds in FYs 2002-03 and 2005-06 from San Bernardino County's Unprogrammed Share Balance as an advance from San Bernardino County shares for the I-15/Baseline Interchange.</p>
02S-016	<p>Action Update: This item was noticed at the July 2002 Commission meeting.</p> <p>Summary: This amendment programs \$8,485,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds from San Mateo County's Unprogrammed Share Balance in FY 2005-06 towards a \$19,463,000 Grade Separation project at Tilton and Poplar Avenues as follows: \$1,000,000 for Plans, Specification & Estimate (PS&E); \$5,500,000 for Right of Way (R/W) acquisition; and \$1,985,000 for construction.</p>
