RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve Relinquishment Resolutions R-3502 - R-3503.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summaries.

R-3502 – 03-Sac-99-PM 17.1 (Request No. 31011-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Sacramento, at Stockton Boulevard, consisting of reconstructed county road. The County by cooperative agreement dated October 25, 1994, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired October 1, 2001, without exception.

R-3503 – 10-SJ-4-PM R17.5/R19.5 (Request No. 13534) – 7 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of San Joaquin, at the intersection of Route 4 and Route 99, consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads, cul-de-sacs and a nonmotorized transportation facility, namely a walkway. The County by resolution dated November 14, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
