RECOMMENDATION

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the following Resolution.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$4,959,000 be allocated from the Budget Acts of 1999 and 2001, Items 2660-01-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for seven (7) Local Assistance STIP projects.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution allocates \$4,959,000 in the State Highway Account and Federal Trust funds for seven (7) local RIP projects listed in the 2000 STIP at an estimated cost of \$8,222,000 including \$3,263,000 contributions from other sources.
