**ENVIRONMENTAL ENHANCEMENT AND MITIGATION PROJECTS**

**RESOLUTION FP-01-39**

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the following Resolution.

**FINANCIAL RESOLUTION**

Resolved, that \$680,400 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2001, Item 2660-101-0183 for three (3) Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation (EEM) Program projects.

**SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

This resolution allocates a total of \$680,400 in State funds for three (3) EEM projects included in the approved project list at an estimated cost of \$852,900 including \$172,500 from other sources.

The statute mandates the Resources Agency to evaluate proposals and the Commission to award grants to fund proposals recommended by the Resource Agency. The 2001/02 EEM Program was adopted at the July 11-12, 2001 Commission meeting.
