RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolutions R-3515 - R-3523.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summaries.

R-3515 – 4-Ala-880-PM 25.5/26.1 (Request No. 56049) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Oakland, between Edgewater Drive and Hassler Way, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets. The City by freeway agreement dated January 17, 1995, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The City by letter dated May 8, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement.

R-3516 – 7-LA-2-PM 3.9/5.9 (Request No. 1179B) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes a portion of Route 2 right of way in the City of Los Angeles, from Route 405 to Moreno Drive, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated April 4, 2002, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 825, Statutes of 2001, which amended Section 302 of the Streets and Highways Code.

R-3519 – 8-Riv-86,111-PM 17.3/21.5,24.5/T30.0 (Request No. 420R) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Coachella, along Route 86, from Avenue 48 to Airport Boulevard (Avenue 56), and along Route 111, from Avenue 48 to Airport Boulevard (Avenue 56), consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment. The City by relinquishment cooperative agreement, dated April 10, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3520 – 8-SBd-30-PM 9.6/9.9 (Request No. 427S) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Rancho Cucamonga, at Smokestone Street and Mulberry Street, consisting of reconstructed city streets. The City by Resolution No. 99-180, dated August 18, 1999, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3521 – 8-SBd-30-PM 9.4/9.9 (Request No. 430S) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Rancho Cucamonga, from East Avenue to Mulberry Street, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment. The City by Resolution No. 02-121, dated April 17, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3522 – 12-Ora-90-KP 12.87/16.25 (Request No. R120006) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes a portion of Route 90 right of way in the City of Yorba Linda, between the city limit line easterly of Rose Drive and Yorba Linda Boulevard, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated May 16, 2002, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 27, Statutes of 2002, which amended Section 390 of the Streets and Highways Code.

R-3523 – 12-Ora-90-KP 16.25/18.91 (Request No. R120007) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes a portion of Route 90 right of way in the City of Yorba Linda, from Yorba Linda Boulevard to the city limit line north of Orangethorpe Avenue, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated May 16, 2002, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 27, Statutes of 2002, which amended Section 390 of the Streets and Highways Code.
