Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

ISSUE:

The collateral facilities included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishment a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the summary.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends the Commission approve the following four Relinquishment Resolutions:

Resolution No. R-3536 – 06-Tul-65-PM 21.9/29.8 (Request No. 82855) – 12 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the County of Tulare, consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads, and frontage roads. The County by resolution dated October 22, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3537 – 07-LA-60-PM 11.0 (Request No. 1223) – 1 Segment
Relinquishes right of way in the City of South El Monte, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city street and frontage road. The City by cooperative agreement dated September 24, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3538 – 07-LA-105-PM R5.5/R6.0 (Request No. 1218) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Los Angeles, consisting of cul-de-sacs and a non-motorized transportation facility, namely a pedestrian walkway. The County by freeway agreement dated November 15, 1983, and by letters dated May 7, 2002 and December 19, 2002, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired January 14, 2001.

Resolution No. R-3541 – 12-Ora-5-PM 37.5 (Request No. R120009) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Anaheim, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city street and a cul-de-sac. The City by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State and by resolution dated December 17, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement.
