## **SUMMARY:**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-11, State Highway Account funds of \$143,900 have been allocated for one (1) Seismic Retrofit Phase 2 project described below.

Project #1 Near Vallejo at the Sonoma Creek Bridge. Initial project constructed a roadside enhancement consisting of an observation deck, two benches, trash containers, driveway, parking lot and pedestrian path. The roadside enhancement is a fulfillment of a Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC) permit requirement for the completed seismic retrofit of the Sonoma Creek Bridge. This supplemental request pays for placing steel sheet piles in the levee below the newly constructed deck to prevent tidal salty water from contaminating farm land on the opposite side of the levee.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On March 30, 1994, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) delegated to the Department of Transportation (Department) authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-11, as amended by Resolution G-00-11, for seismic retrofit projects. This authority allows the Department to begin work without waiting for the next Commission meeting to receive an allocation.

This project is part of the legislatively mandated Bridge Seismic Retrofit Program (SB131), approved by the Governors Office on March 15, 1994.
