Ref: **INFORMATIONAL REPORT - SEISMIC RETROFIT PROJECT PHASE 1 ALLOCATION**

## **SUMMARY:**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-11, State Highway Account funds of \$975,000 have been allocated for one (1) Seismic Retrofit Phase 1 project described below.

Project # 1. In Monterey County, approximately 12 miles south of Carmel. Initial project was for the multi-column seismic retrofit of the Bixby Creek and Rocky Creek bridges. Project construction was completed November 8, 2000. This supplemental allocation pays for a final arbitration settlement.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On March 30, 1994, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) delegated to the Department of Transportation (Department) authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-11, as revised by Resolution G-94, for seismic retrofit projects. This authority allows the Department to begin work without waiting for the next Commission meeting to receive an allocation.

This project is part of the legislatively mandated Bridge Seismic Retrofit Program (SB131), approved by the Governors Office on March 15, 1994.
