ISSUE:

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:

- Routes 101 and 23 in Ventura County – Interchange improvement in Thousand Oaks.

This project is fully funded in the 2004 State Transportation Improvement Program for construction in Fiscal Year 2008-09. Funds for the project will come from the Regional Transportation Improvement Program. The total estimated project cost is \$30,832,000.

A copy of the Negative Declaration has been provided to California Transportation Commission (Commission) staff. The Department of Transportation (Department) has approved the project for construction. This approval and the filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-05-13.


