Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **ISSUE:**

The facilities in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are safe and drivable or have been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolutions:

### **Resolution No. R-3597 – 12-Ora-1-PM 0.96/4.63 (Request No. R120005) – 1 Segment**

Relinquishes a portion of Route 1 right of way in the City of Dana Point, from the west edge of the San Juan Creek Bridge to the northerly City limit near Eastline Road, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated August 3, 2004, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 757, Statutes of 2001, which amended Section 301 of the Streets and Highways Code.

### **Resolution No. R-3599 – 12-Ora-73-PM 4.8/5.6 (Request No. R120003) – 2 Segments**

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Newport Beach, along Bristol Street and North Bristol Street, from Jamboree Road to Irwin Avenue/Campus Drive, consisting of frontage roads. The City, by cooperative agreement dated May 20, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3600 – 12-Ora-73-PM 5.6/5.9 (Request No. R120002) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Orange, along Bristol Street and North Bristol Street, consisting of frontage roads. The County, by cooperative agreement dated July 27, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3601 – 3-Sac-275-KP 0.11/1.13 (Request No. 31970-X) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes a portion of Route 275 right of way in the City of Sacramento, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated October 19, 2004, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 1220, Statutes of 1994, which added Section 73.1 to the Streets and Highways Code and by Chapter 1154, Statutes of 1996, which repealed Section 575 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution No. R-3602 – 4-SCI-9-KP 11.3/11.9 (Request No. 56066) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Saratoga, between Saratoga-Los Gatos Road and 0.13 kilometer west of Sixth Street, consisting of nonmotorized transportation facilities, namely sidewalks. The City, by cooperative agreement dated November 17, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3603 – 7-LA-72-PM 6.8/6.9 & 8.0/8.5 (Request No. 1224) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes a portion of Route 72 right of way in the City of Pico Rivera, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated March 1, 2004, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 106, Statutes of 1988, which amended Section 372 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution No. R-3610 – 11-SD-15-PM 3.4/6.0 (Request No. R27208) – 18 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of San Diego, between Dwight Street and 0.05 mile north of Adams Avenue, consisting of superseded highway right of way, reconstructed and relocated city streets, frontage roads and cul-de-sacs. The City, by freeway agreement dated May 14, 1985, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired June 13, 2005, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3611 – 12-Ora-5-PM 38.7/39.5 (Request No. R120018) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Anaheim, between Euclid Way and Cherry Street, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets, frontage roads and cul-de-sacs. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and by amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired June 5, 2005, without exception.
