Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

ISSUE:

It has been determined that the facility in the specific relinquishment resolution summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State highway system and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all right, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. Consequently, the facility been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolution:

Resolution No. R-3633 – 10-Mer-99-PM 32.3/36.2 (Request No. 15485) – 12 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the County of Merced, between Sycamore Avenue and Early Dawn Road, consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads, frontage roads and cul-de-sacs. The County, by freeway agreement, dated February 20, 1968, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State and by resolution, dated October 25, 2005, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
