RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission), as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-06-09.

ISSUE:

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration (ND) has been completed:

- Route 395 in Inyo County – Rehabilitate roadway near Little Lake.

This project in Inyo County will rehabilitate, and bring to current standards, a 3.3-mile portion of Route 395 near Little Lake. The project includes new asphalt overlay, realigning two curves, and widening shoulders to current standards. This project is fully funded in the 2006 State Highway Operation and Protection Program. The total estimated project cost is \$9,056,000. It is estimated to begin construction in FY 2008-09.

A copy of the Negative Declaration has been provided to Commission staff. The Department has approved this project for construction. This approval and the filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.




Figure 1-1 Project Vicinity Map
