RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission), as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-06-15.

ISSUE:

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration (ND) has been completed:

- Route 16 in Yolo County – Install left turn pocket near Woodland.

BACKGROUND:

This project is fully funded in the 2006 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP). The total estimated project cost is \$2.57 million. Construction is estimated to begin in Fiscal Year 2006-2007.

An ND was prepared because an Incidental Take Permit was required pursuant to the California Endangered Species Act for potential impacts to the Swainson's hawk, a State-listed Threatened species. A copy of the ND has been provided to Commission staff.

The Department has approved this project for construction. This approval and the filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.


Resolution E-06-15
