Ref.: **ADOPTION OF THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2006-07 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5310 ELDERLY AND DISABLED PERSONS TRANSIT PROGRAM**

**Recommendation:** Commission staff recommends that the Commission authorize the Department of Transportation (Department) to fund projects on the attached list in priority order to the level of *actual funding* made available in the Federal Budget. The current estimate of available funding for the Program in Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2006-07 is \$14 million, including the required 11.47% local match. The Department has indicated that project savings of \$2 million from previous cycles is also available to fund projects contained on the project list.

The attached list is comprised of all projects that were on the September 2006 draft prioritized project list. The priority list will both serve to clarify the relative sequence of funding for projects, as well as offer a ready source of additional projects if certain higher priority projects do not move ahead or if additional funds above the original estimated amount become available.

**FFY 2006-07 Program Cycle:** For the FFY 2006-07 Program, the Regional Transportation Planning Agencies (RTPA) submitted 124 eligible applications for approximately 442 projects. This represents a request for \$20.3 million in Program funds. In accordance with the Commission's adopted procedures, all applications were scored locally using the Program procedures adopted by the Commission in January 1997 (Resolution G-97-01). The State Review Committee subsequently reviewed and, in some cases, modified the regional score for those projects, again, using the Commission's adopted procedures. Projects with a scoring difference between the regional and the State Review Committee scores were discussed with the RTPA.

Commission staff and the State Review Committee conducted a staff level conference on September 13, 2006 for all stakeholders to discuss the statewide-prioritized list and hear any appeals on technical issues that affected the scoring. Four written appeals were presented to the State Review Committee during the staff level conference. No verbal appeals were heard.

After discussion of the appeals and review of the original application documents, two projects were moved from the 110% funding category to the 100% funding category; one project score was changed as the original application documentation supported the appeal and the other project score was changed due to a scoring calculation error. Two additional projects moved from below the 110% funding category to

within the 110% funding category based on scoring changes as the original application documentation supported the appeals.

A statewide-priority list (attached) was subsequently assembled based on the rescoring. It is important to note that the scoring changes made will not affect any projects that are expected to be funded this cycle. The addition of the two projects within the 100% funding category did not affect those projects that were on the September 2006 draft prioritized list. All projects that were identified remain within the 100% funding category. Due to the addition of two projects in the 110% funding category as mentioned above, and the project savings from previous cycles, the funding line has been changed to 115%.

Since the projects on the prioritized list will only be funded down to the amount of actual available funding, all of the projects that had been on the September 2006 draft prioritized project list will remain on the statewide-prioritized list, with the projects listed in priority order according to Commission policy.

The Commission must hold a public hearing to discuss the prioritized list and overall Program policy. After the hearing, the Commission may consider staff's recommendations and adopt the attached Program of Projects.

### **Background**

The Program was established in 1975 and has been administered by the Department since its inception. It provides annual grants of federal funds to purchase transit capital equipment to meet the specialized needs of elderly and/or disabled persons for whom mass transportation services are unavailable, insufficient, or inappropriate. The Program serves a variety of client groups and programs ranging from small agencies with specific clientele (e.g., dialysis and AIDS patients) to paratransit providers serving entire communities. Most of these agencies are non-profit organizations while some are public agencies where no non-profit organizations are readily available to provide the specialized service. An 11.47% local match is required from all Program participants.

In 1996, AB 772 passed directing the Commission to have oversight responsibilities for the Program. AB 772 placed three mandates on the Commission regarding the Program: (1) the Commission shall direct the Department on how to allocate funds for the Program, (2) the Commission shall establish an appeals process for the Program, and (3) the Commission shall hold at least one public hearing prior to approving its Program of Projects.

In January of 1997, the Commission approved the procedures and criteria for the Program that utilize project scoring criteria and a State Review Committee consisting of representatives from the State Departments of Rehabilitation, Aging, Developmental Services and Transportation, with Commission staff acting in the role of facilitator/coordinator for the State Review Committee.

In accordance with the Commission's adopted procedures, the RTPA or its designated Regional Evaluation Committee score projects within their jurisdiction utilizing the Commission's adopted project scoring criteria and forwards a scored list of their projects to the Department. The RTPA must notify its applicants of their project scores and provide information about the local appeals process. The State Review Committee rescors the projects to verify the scores given at the regional level. In those instances where there is a sizable difference between regional and State Review Committee project scores, the Department contacts the regions and the differences are thoroughly discussed.

A statewide prioritized list of projects is then created representing the estimated available funds. Typically, the Commission adopts the Program of Projects down to the 110% funding level to allow flexibility if projects within 100% of available funding are not completed.

## CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

### ADOPTION OF FEDERAL FY 2006-07 ELDERLY AND DISABLED PERSONS TRANSIT PROGRAM

#### Resolution G-06-\_\_\_\_\_

- 1.1 WHEREAS, Federal law (Title 49 U.S.C. Section 5310) provides for capital grants for the purpose of assisting private non-profit corporations and under certain circumstances, public agencies in providing transportation services to meet the needs of elderly persons and persons with disabilities for whom public mass transportation services are otherwise **unavailable, insufficient, or inappropriate**; and
- 1.2 WHEREAS, State law, AB 772 (Chapter 669, Statutes of 1996), placed three mandates on the Commission regarding the Program as follows:
  1. The Commission shall direct the Department on how to allocate funds for the Program.
  2. The Commission shall establish an appeals process for the Program.
  3. The Commission shall hold at least one public hearing prior to approving its Program of Projects; and
- 1.3 WHEREAS, the Commission worked with a 15-member advisory committee made up of individuals from the Regional Transportation Agencies, state and local social service agencies, the California Association for Coordinated Transportation, the Department and Commission staff, to develop a Program process that will provide for a statewide ranked list of projects to be adopted by the Commission and funded by the Department; and
- 1.4 WHEREAS, the Commission adopted a process utilizing project scoring criteria and a State Review Committee consisting of representatives from the State Departments of Rehabilitation, Developmental Services, Aging and Transportation, with Commission staff acting in the role of facilitator/coordinator for the state committee; and
- 1.5 WHEREAS, the Commission's adopted Program process has been complied with and the public hearing has been held; and
- 2.1 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission adopts the attached list of projects as recommended by Commission staff as the Federal FY 2006-07 Elderly and Disabled Persons Transit (Section 5310) Program; and
- 2.2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in adopting the list, the Commission hereby directs the Department to allocate funds for projects on that list down to the level of actual available funding, pursuant to California Government Code Section 14055.2(b).
