Subject: **FINANCIAL ALLOCATION FOR STATE-ADMINISTERED STIP PROJECTS
ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM
RESOLUTION FP-07-54**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following resolution, allocating \$709,000 for two State-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects on the State Highway System as follows:

- o \$89,000 for one State-administered STIP project; and
- o \$620,000 for one State-administered STIP Transportation Enhancement project.

ISSUE:

The attached vote list describes two State-administered STIP projects on the State Highway System totaling \$709,000. The Department is ready to proceed with these projects and is requesting an allocation at this time.

These projects are being allocated from the Transportation Investment Fund (TIF). Changes to the projected allocation capacity, however, may result in future technical changes to the Transportation Facilities Account (Proposition 1B) for STIP projects.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that \$160,000 be allocated from Non-Budget Act Item 2660-801-3008, and \$549,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2007, Budget Act Item 2660-301-0890 for two State-administered STIP projects, as described on the attached vote list.

The Department has complied with the National Environmental Policy Act and the California Environmental Quality Act requirements in preparing these projects.
