Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

## **ISSUE:**

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all right, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. Consequently, the facility is safe and drivable, or has been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RESOLUTIONS:**

Resolution R-3687 – 3-Pla-80-PM 0.5  
(Request No. 035504-X) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Roseville, on Riverside Avenue between Cirby Way and Interstate 80. The City, by resolution dated October 17, 2007, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The City, by letter dated December 10, 2007, waived the 90-day notice requirement.

Resolution R-3688 – 4-CC-680-PM 16.8/R17.7

(Request No. 56027) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Pleasant Hill, on North Main Street, Contra Costa Boulevard, and Monument Boulevard, between the southerly city limit line and north to Monument Boulevard, consisting of relocated and reconstructed city streets, frontage roads, and other State constructed local roads. The City, by freeway agreement dated March 7, 1988, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired February 19, 2008, without exception.

Resolution R-3683 – 8-Riv-111-PM 38.02/40.71

(Request No. 455-R) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Palm Desert, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement, dated December 10, 2007, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 594, Statutes of 2005, which amended Section 411 of the Streets and Highways Code.
