Subject: **APPROVAL OF 2008 STATE HIGHWAY OPERATION AND PROTECTION PROGRAM
RESOLUTION G-08-05**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the proposed 2008 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP), as amended by the attached document. A copy of the proposed 2008 SHOPP was transmitted to the Commission on January 31, 2008.

ISSUE:

The Department's 2008 SHOPP was prepared in response to Government Code Section 14526.5, Streets and Highways Code Section 164.6, and the strategies outlined in the Department's Policy for Management of the SHOPP. Government Code Section 14526.5 requires the Commission to approve and submit the SHOPP to the Legislature and the Governor, no later than April 1 in even-numbered years.

Following Commission approval of the SHOPP, the Department will work closely with the various regional transportation planning agencies to incorporate the SHOPP into their regional federal transportation improvement programs to establish federal funding eligibility.

BACKGROUND:

The 2008 SHOPP is a four year program (from Fiscal Years 2008-09 through 2011-12) that includes projects for safety, emergency, legal mandates, bridge preservation, roadway preservation, roadside preservation, mobility, and highway related facilities.

The 2008 SHOPP utilizes \$8.429 billion for capital outlay and capital outlay support over the four-year period. This funding level is consistent with the 2008 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Fund Estimate approved by the Commission in October 2007. The selection of new projects, primarily programmed in the last two fiscal years of the SHOPP, is consistent with and guided by the 2007 Ten-Year State Highway Operation and Protection Plan previously reviewed by the Commission.

The 2008 SHOPP also reserves funding for debt service for Grant Anticipation Revenue Vehicle (GARVEE) financed projects. Projects proposed for GARVEE financing are a combination of strategically significant roadway, bridge, and goods movement projects in support of the Goods Movement Action Plan.

Projects proposed for allocation in Fiscal Year 2007-08 are not included in the 2008 SHOPP.
