Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

## **ISSUE:**

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. The facility is safe and drivable, or has been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RESOLUTIONS:**

Resolution R-3691 – 2-Sis-139-PM 1.0/4.0  
(Request No. 10093) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Siskiyou, at Osborne Road, Havlina Road, Akins Road, Tschirky Road, and Walsh Road (Road No. 0U018), consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads. The County, by resolutions dated July 15, 1997, and December 15, 1998, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3692 – 2-Mod-395-PM 22.8/23.1

(Request No. 10464) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Alturas, at Court Street, East Street, East A Street, and East B Street, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets. The City, by resolution dated January 8, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3693 – 2-Sha-299-PM 96.1/99.3

(Request No. 10772) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Shasta, at County Road No. 9S060 (Lewis Road), County Road No. 9S061 (Williams Road), County Road No. 9S02 (Pittville Road), County Road No. 9S062 (Lee Ranch Road), and County Road No. 9S066 (Pittville Totten Road), consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads. The County, by resolution dated January 22, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3694 – 2-Sha-89-PM 36.9

(Request No. 10298) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Shasta, at County Road No. 9S01 (McArthur Road), consisting of a reconstructed and relocated county road. The County, by resolution dated January 22, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3695 – 3-Sac-16-PM 12.5

(Request No. 034756-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Rancho Cordova, at Grant Line Road, consisting of a reconstructed city street. The City, by letter dated October 31, 2007, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
