Subject: **VACATION RESOLUTIONS**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the vacation resolutions summarized below.

## **ISSUE:**

It has been determined that each facility in the specific vacation resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by vacation. Upon the recording of the approved vacation resolution in the county where the facility is located, the public's right of use of the facility will be abandoned. The vacations comply with Sections 892, 8313 and 8330.5 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RESOLUTION:**

Resolution No. A-869 – 2-Teh-36-PM 99.7/99.9  
(Request No. 10774) - 1 Segment

Vacates right of way along State Route 36 in the county of Tehama, between 0.1 and 0.3 miles northwest of the intersection with State Route 32, consisting of highway right of way no longer needed for State highway purposes. The County was given a 90-day notice of intent to vacate, without protesting such action.

Resolution No. A-870 – 3-Sac-16-PM R16.7/R16.9  
(Request No. 031492-Z) - 2 Segments

Vacates right of way along State Route 16 in the county of Sacramento near Sloughouse, between 0.1 miles west and 0.2 miles east of the intersection with Latrobe Road, consisting of highway right of way no longer needed for State highway purposes. The County was given a 90-day notice of intent to vacate, without protesting such action.
