## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission approve an allocation of \$48,200,000 for one multi-programmed project on Route 101 in Rohnert Park to be funded with \$41,700,000 from the Corridor Mobility Improvement Account (CMIA) and \$6,500,000 from the Transportation Facilities Account [TFA - State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)].

The Department also recommends that the Commission approve this allocation contingent upon the enactment of the 2008-09 Budget Act.

## **ISSUE:**

The attached vote list describes one State-administered CMIA and STIP project on the State Highway System for \$48,200,000, plus \$15,070,000 from other sources. The Department is ready to proceed with this project and is requesting an allocation at this time.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$41,700,000 be allocated from Budget Act of 2008, Budget Act Item 2660-304-6055, and \$6,500,000 be allocated from Budget Act Item 2660-304-6058, for one State-administered CMIA and STIP project as described on the attached vote list, contingent upon passage of the FY 2008-09 Budget Act.
