Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. The facility is safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-3709 – 2-Sha-5-PM R50.4/R50.9
(Request No. 10082-A) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Shasta near the Pollard Flat overcrossing along Route 5, consisting of relocated or reconstructed county roads or frontage roads. The County, by freeway agreement dated March 14, 1989, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State and by letter dated April 24, 1995, waived the 90-day notice requirement. The County has been contacted during the past year and still concurs with the relinquishment.

Resolution R-3711 – 11-SD-125-PM 19.0/19.2(Request No. R31108) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of San Diego along Route 125 near Fletcher Parkway on East Lake Drive between Flume Road and Lake Angela Drive, consisting of relocated and reconstructed city streets. The City, by freeway agreement dated April 13, 1965, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice was received by the City on May 5, 2006. The City, by letter dated August 11, 2006, requested that the Department complete repairs prior to relinquishment of the right of way and by letter dated July 7, 2008, accepted the work performed for the relinquishment and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3712 – 8-Riv-86S-PM R2.54/R18.27(Request No. 447R) – 17 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Riverside along Route 86S south of the Coachella city limits between Avenue 52 and Avenue 82, consisting of relocated or reconstructed county roads. The County, by freeway agreement dated August 13, 1974, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired September 8, 2008.

Resolution R-3713 – 5-SLO-227-PM 0.00/0.97(Request No. 11094) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Arroyo Grande on Route 227 from Route 101 to 250 feet north of Huasna Road, under terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment agreement, dated October 15, 2008, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 787, Statutes of 2000, which amended Section 527 of the Streets and Highways Code.
