Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. The facility is safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-3753 – 05-SBt-156U-PM 9.08/9.13; 05-SBt-156-PM R8.92
(Request No. 8836) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of San Benito along Route 156U at the San Benito River Bridge, consisting of superseded highway right of way, and along Route 156 at Buena Vista Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The County of San Benito, by resolution dated September 22, 2009, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3754 – 11-Imp-111-PM T8.2/13.6
(Request No. R31099-A and R31099-B) – 11 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Imperial along Route 111 between Ross Road and Robinson Road, consisting of superseded highway right of way and collateral facilities. The County of Imperial, by controlled access highway agreements dated September 22, 1998 and January 25, 2000, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired January 24, 2010, without exception.

Resolution R-3755 – 11-SD-15-PM M5.5
(Request No. R31152) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of San Diego along Route 15 on 40th Street between Madison and Adams Avenues, consisting of a relocated and reconstructed city street. The City of San Diego, by freeway agreement dated May 14, 1985, and by letter dated January 8, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3756 – 12-Ora-39-PM 19.2
(Request No. R120043) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of La Habra along Route 39 on Imperial Highway between Brass Lantern Drive and Route 39, consisting of a collateral facility. The City of La Habra, by resolution dated October 19, 2009, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
