Subject: **TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO PREVIOUSLY APPROVED RESOLUTIONS –  
RESOLUTION FP-09-55**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve two technical corrections to Resolution FP-09-55, originally approved June 30, 2010, for \$76,971,000, for 49 locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects off the State Highway System.

## **ISSUE:**

The attached vote list describes 49 locally-administered STIP projects off the State Highway System. A technical correction is needed for Project 4 (PPNO 2176), Project 11 (PPNO 2140) and Project 19 (PPNO 6414) to change the Item Number (from 101-0042 to 101-0890) and Fund Type (from SHA to FTF). An additional technical correction is needed for Project 19 (PPNO 6414) to change the project starting point from Avenue 396 to Avenue 384. A technical correction is also needed for Project 25 (PPNO 9380), to modify the programmed amount from San Benito County, add the programmed amount from Monterey County, and delete the text related to the Monterey County TE Reserves. There are no changes to the amounts allocated for the projects.

There are no changes to the original book item memorandum. The required changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold, on the attached document.
