ADMINISTERED TRADE CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT FUNDS PROJECT OFF  
THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM  
RESOLUTION TCIF-AA-1213-16, AMENDING RESOLUTION TCIF-A-0708-01**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) amend Resolution TCIF-A-0708-01 to de-allocate \$1,047,000 in Proposition 1B Trade Corridor Improvement Funds (TCIF) for Project 42, Columbia Avenue Grade Separation project (PPNO TC42) in Riverside County, reducing the original TCIF allocation of \$6,000,000 to \$4,953,000, to reflect contract savings.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On June 26, 2008, the Commission allocated \$6,000,000 in TCIF funds under Resolution TCIF-A-0708-01 to the Columbia Avenue Grade Separation project. The contract has been completed with a savings of \$1,047,000 in TCIF funds. The necessary changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold on the attached revised vote list.

## **RESOLUTION:**

Be it Resolved, that the \$6,000,000 for the Trade Corridor Improvement Fund (104-6056) originally allocated under Resolution TCIF-A-0708-01 for the Columbia Avenue Grade Separation project (PPNO TC42) in Riverside County, is hereby amended by \$1,047,000, reducing the Proposition 1B TCIF financial allocation from \$6,000,000 to \$4,953,000, in accordance with the attached revised vote list.
