Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

## **ISSUE:**

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolutions in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agencies identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RESOLUTIONS:**

Resolution R-3913 – 02-Plu-70-PM R78.2  
(Request No. 10467) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Plumas along Route 70 at 0.6 miles west of Grizzly Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The County, by resolution dated April 16, 2013, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3914 – 03-Pla-49-PM 4.5/6.4  
(Request No. 033568-X) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Placer along Route 49 from Marguerite Mine Road to Bell Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The County, by cooperative agreement dated June 8, 2004 and by letter signed September 19, 2013, agreed to waive the 90-day notice requirement and accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3915 – 03-Pla-49-PM 3.3/4.2  
(Request No. 034013-X) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Auburn along Route 49 at Fulweiler Avenue, Palm Avenue, and Persimmon Drive, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by cooperative agreement dated April 26, 2004 and by letter signed June 26, 2013, agreed to waive the 90-day notice requirement and accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3916 – 06-Fre-180-PM 68.09  
(Request No. 87114) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Fresno along Route 180 at Thompson Avenue, consisting of a collateral facility inadvertently omitted from a previous relinquishment. The County, by controlled access highway agreement dated April 28, 2009, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired October 10, 2014.

Resolution R-3917 – 11-SD-125-PM L1.8  
(Request No. R31145) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of San Diego along Route 125 at Lonestar Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 27, 2000, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired October 28, 2014.

Resolution R-3918 – 11-SD-94-PM 16.4/16.8  
(Request No. R27205) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of San Diego on Route 94 between Miller Ranch Road and Fair Oaks Drive, consisting of superseded highway right of way. The County, by letter dated October 9, 2014, agreed to waive the 90-day notice requirement and accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3919 – 11-Imp-78-PM R9.2/R12.6, 11-Imp-86-PM R23.2/R24.2  
(Request No. R31147) – 8 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Imperial along realigned Route 78 between existing Route 86 and New River and along Route 86 between Fredericks Road and Gardner Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The County, by controlled access highway agreements dated December 17, 1991 and May 6, 2003, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expires December 1, 2014.
