Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

## **ISSUE:**

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolutions in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agencies identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RESOLUTIONS:**

Resolution R-3925 – 03-But-70-PM 4.06  
(Request No. 036175-X) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Butte along Route 70 at East Gridley Road and Stimpson Road, consisting of reconstructed county roads. The County, by relinquishment agreement dated November 3, 2011, and by letter signed March 25, 2015, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3926 – 03-Col-20-PM 3.3/3.5  
(Request No. 036267-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Colusa along Route 20 at Bear Valley Road, consisting of a reconstructed county road. The County, by relinquishment agreement dated December 10, 2013, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3927 – 06-Kin-198-PM T21.65/28.32  
(Request No. 86667) – 10 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Kings along Route 198 between 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, consisting of reconstructed county roads and newly constructed frontage roads. The County, by relinquishment agreement dated January 27, 2015, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3928 – 10-SJ-12-PM 5.1/8.9  
(Request No. 16587) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of San Joaquin along Route 12 between West Terminous Drive and Guard Road, consisting of newly constructed county roads. The County, by relinquishment agreement dated August 25, 2014, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3929 – 11-SD-94-PM 30.59  
(Request No. R34583) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of San Diego along Route 94 at Community Building Road, consisting of a reconstructed county road. The County, by letter dated March 4, 2015, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
