SUMMARY:

This amendment transfers the applicant status on the Harbor Boulevard Wildlife Underpass project from the California Department of Parks and Recreation to the County of Los Angeles. The project was programmed in the second round of the Statewide Transportation Enhancement (STE) share of the Transportation Enhancement Activities (TEA) Program.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approved the following amendment to Resolution G-02-03 (approved April 4, 2002), the adoption of the second round of the STE Program.
