Subject: **FINANCIAL ALLOCATION OF AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT  
ACT OF 2009 (ARRA) FUNDS  
RESOLUTION FS-08-01**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt the attached list of 57 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) and highway maintenance (HM) pavement preservation projects totaling \$625,699,100 to be funded from the Federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA).

The Department further recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$575,699,100 for 31 HM projects and 25 SHOPP projects on the attached list scheduled to be delivered in Fiscal Year (FY) 2008-09. The Department will return for an allocation of ARRA funds for the Doyle Drive (Contract 4) project in San Francisco County (Project 10 on attached list) when the Commission approves the project for future consideration of funding (currently scheduled for April 2009 meeting).

## **ISSUE:**

The attached list describes 57 SHOPP and HM projects totaling \$625,699,100 to be funded with federal funds made available with the enactment of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) and pending state legislative action. At its February 19, 2009 meeting, the Commission approved an initial level of \$500 million in federal stimulus funds. However, the Department is requesting an increased allocation level of \$625 million. Of the \$625 million initial level, \$565 million will be used for construction capital and support on SHOPP projects and \$61 million will be used for construction capital and support on HM projects.

The projects on the attached list have been screened and found to have significant economic benefit. All the projects on the list will be ready to obligate based on the requirements in ARRA and represent high priority SHOPP projects. Applying federal stimulus funds to the SHOPP projects identified on the attached list will enable the Department to fully-fund all SHOPP projects planned for delivery this fiscal year.

**BACKGROUND:**

On February 17, 2009, President Obama signed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 (H.R.1,S.1). This bill includes \$27.5 billion stimulus funding nationwide for highway transportation projects. The State of California's share is approximately \$2.57 billion. The Department is anticipating receiving approximately \$625 million of federal funds to be used for stimulating the economy by providing funds for SHOPP and HM projects. Due to the "Timely Use of Funds" and "Use It or Lose It" provisions of this legislation, the Department will need to move quickly to obligate these new funds and is requesting an allocation at this time. All the projects on the list will be ready to obligate based on the requirements in ARRA.

These new funds are anticipated to be monitored and accounted for separately from the Department's current SHOPP projects funded from the State Highway Account (SHA). To ensure accountability, these funds will have their own reporting requirements at the federal level, and the Department anticipates equal or more stringent reporting requirements at the State level.

The delegation amount requested will be revisited once final official funding levels have been established and pending any legislative actions enacted by the State Legislature and Governor.

**FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$575,699,100 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2008, Budget Act Item 2660-302-0890, for 56 SHOPP and highway maintenance projects described on the attached list.

The Department has complied with the National Environmental Policy Act and the California Environmental Quality Act requirements in preparing these projects.
