Senate Bill 375 (Steinberg)

- Requires regional greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction targets for the 18 Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)
- Adds Sustainable Communities Strategy to MPO Regional Transportation Plans (RTPs)
- Streamlines California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements

Senate Bill 391 (Liu)

Requires Caltrans to:

- Identify the statewide integrated multimodal transportation system
- Prepare Interim Report by December 31, 2012, based on SB 375 sustainable communities strategies
- Develop State Transportation Plan by December 31, 2015 that identifies the integrated, multimodal system needed to achieve the maximum feasible greenhouse gas reductions


California Interregional Blueprint Highlights

- Integration of statewide modal plans into a single document
- Development of improved data and tools – including interregional travel
- Built on Regional Transportation and Regional Blueprint Plans
