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Subject: **STIP AMENDMENT 10S-060**

## **SUMMARY:**

The California Department of Transportation will request that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the requested State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment at the next scheduled Commission meeting following the notice period.

## **ISSUE:**

The City of Redding proposes to amend the 2010 STIP to program Regional Improvement Program Transportation Enhancement (TE) funding on the Diestelhorst Bridge Rehabilitation Project (PPNO 2505).

## **BACKGROUND**

The Diestelhorst Bridge is a key river crossing for the Sacramento River Trail and provides general pedestrian and bicycle connectivity. Currently programmed in the Federal Highway Bridge Program, the bridge structure is deteriorating and will be fixed to prevent structural failure and/or unsafe conditions. It is now proposed to add transportation enhancements to this historic structure, which will further accommodate bicycle and pedestrian traffic while retaining its historic value. Per the STIP guidelines, TE funds can be used for the restoration of historic structures, and the Diestelhorst Bridge is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places, since it was constructed in 1914.
