

Planning for a sustainable future in the San Diego region

Draft 2050 Regional Transportation Plan/ Sustainable Communities Strategy

- Meets state greenhouse gas reduction targets
- \$196 billion in transportation investments planned
- \$4.8 billion annually in projected regional economic output
- Creates 39,500 jobs per year in the San Diego region
- Preserves more than half of our land as open space, parkland, and habitat
- Provides 156 new miles of trolley service
- Proposes new trolley tunnel in downtown San Diego
- Expands and speeds up COASTER service in the North Coast Corridor
- More than doubles transit service miles with increased frequency in key corridors
- Takes advantage of the state's investment in High Speed Rail to address intercity transportation needs and limited airport capacity
- 130 miles of managed lanes to facilitate carpools, vanpools, and premium bus service
- \$3.4 billion for regional and local bicycle and pedestrian projects and programs
- Creates new carpool and telework incentive programs to reduce solo driving
- Accommodates housing to meet projected population growth in San Diego County
- Calls for equitable distribution of investments throughout the region
