Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

### **ISSUE:**

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolutions in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agencies identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

### **RESOLUTIONS:**

Resolution R-3841 – 04-CC-4-PM 23.1  
(Request No. 56091) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Pittsburg along Route 4 on Railroad Avenue, consisting of a collateral facility. The City, by letter dated March 16, 2012, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3842– 07-LA-66-PM 3.2/5.3  
(Request No. 1229C) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Claremont on Route 66 between the city limits of Pomona and Upland, under terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment agreement dated May 25, 2012, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 499, Statutes of 2010, which amended Section 366 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution R-3843 – 07-LA-405-PM 38.9/39.0  
(Request No. 1237) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Los Angeles along Route 405 on Dickens Street, consisting of a collateral facility. The City, by freeway agreement dated March 24, 2003, and by City Council Action on April 24, 2012, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3844 – 10-SJ-99-PM 20.2/20.9  
(Request No. 16575) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of San Joaquin along Route 99 on Cherokee and Waterloo Roads, consisting of collateral facilities inadvertently omitted from a previous relinquishment. The County, by agreement dated March 22, 2012, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3845 – 10-Mer-59-PM 23.3  
(Request No. 16413) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Merced along Route 59 on Oakdale Road, consisting of a collateral facility. The County, by relinquishment agreement dated May 16, 2012, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
