## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) allocate \$123,700,000 for the State administered multi-funded Proposition 1B State Route 99 (SR99)/State-Local Partnership Program (SLPP) SR 99 (South Stockton) Widening (PPNO 7668) project in San Joaquin County, on the State Highway System.

## **ISSUE:**

The attached vote list describes one State administered SR99/SLPP project programmed in Fiscal Year (FY) 2011-12 and 2012-13 totaling \$123,700,000, plus \$36,800,000 from other sources. The Department is ready to proceed with this project and is requesting an allocation at this time.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$123,700,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2011, Budget Act Items 2660-004-6072, 2660-304-6072, and 2660-304-6060 for one State administered Proposition 1B SR99/SLPP Program project described in the attached vote box.

Be it further resolved, that as a condition of allocation of these funds and to perform its administrative role established by Senate Bill 88, the Commission requests that the Department perform the functions necessary to ensure proper accountability measures are employed and reporting requirements are met for the Proposition 1B State Route 99 Program.
