



CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION
Commission Consent to the Department's
Ten-Year California State Rail Plan
Resolution G-02-07

- 1.1 WHEREAS the California Transportation Commission (Commission) is required by Government Code Section 14036 to give its advice and consent on the Department of Transportation (Department) Rail Passenger Program Report; and
- 1.2 WHEREAS the Department has prepared the 2002 California State Rail Plan in order to provide a comprehensive 10-year plan; and
- 1.3 WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the draft of the California State Rail Plan at its November 2001 meeting and the final report at its February 2002 meeting; and
- 1.4 WHEREAS the Commission provided advice on the draft State Rail Plan and requested that the final ten-year plan contain a constrained historic funding alternative provide some context to the \$4 billion in potential funding for capital improvements; and
- 1.5 WHEREAS Caltrans' final ten-year report incorporated the Commission's advice; and
- 1.6 WHEREAS the Commission, in granting its consent at its February 2002 meeting recommended that Caltrans include in its 2004 Ten-Year Rail Plan more information: on life cycle capital costs; on rail and land use in the Central Valley; and on emissions from mobile sources (cars and locomotives).
- 1.7 WHEREAS Caltrans agreed to include the provisions requested in Section 1.6.
- 2.1 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission does hereby consent to the information contained in the California State Rail Plan and directs the Department to transmit to the Legislature, the Governor, and the Public Utilities Commission in connection with the 10-Year State Rail Plan for FY 2001-02 to FY 2010-11.
