Commission Consent to the Department's
Ten-Year California State Rail Plan
Resolution G-05-11

- 1.1 WHEREAS, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) is required by Government Code Section 14036 to give its advice and consent on the Department of Transportation (Department) 10-year State Rail Plan; and
- 1.2 WHEREAS, the Department has prepared the 2005 California State Rail Plan for FY 2005-06 through FY 2015-16 in order to provide a comprehensive 10-year plan; and
- 1.3 WHEREAS, the Commission has reviewed the California State Rail Plan at its November 2005 meeting; and
- 1.4 WHEREAS, the Commission advised the Department that the State Rail Plan should include:
- a discussion of the benefits of a stable funding source and increased funding to address future capital and operating requirements.
 - a discussion on the need for a dedicated and reliable funding source to perform the major overhaul of locomotives and passenger cars and acquisition of new equipment.
- 1.5 WHEREAS, the Department has agreed to incorporate the Commission's advice into its final ten-year report.
- 2.1 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission does hereby consent to the information contained in the California State Rail Plan and directs the Department to transmit to the Legislature, the Governor, and the Public Utilities Commission the 10-year State Rail Plan for FY 2005-06 through FY 2015-16.
