**Limit the Public Transportation Account Funding to
Non Article XIX Eligible Projects**

Resolution G-98-27

- 1.1 WHEREAS, the enactment of Senate Bill 45 eliminated the Transit Capital Improvement (TCI) Program and rolled TCI-type projects into the STIP; and
- 1.2 WHEREAS, the intent was to have all projects compete at the regional level for their proper priority; and
- 1.3 WHEREAS, many TCI Program projects are eligible for State Highway Account funding; and
- 1.4 WHEREAS, at the October 28, 1998 meeting, the California Transportation Commission's Public Transit Committee recommended that the Commission adopt a policy that limits future Public Transportation Account funds only to non-State Highway Account eligible projects.
- 2.1 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the California Transportation Commission, hereby limits Public Transportation Account funds only to non-State Highway Account eligible projects.
