1998 VINCENT THOMAS TOLL BRIDGE PROGRAM
REHABILITATION PROJECTS**

- 1.1 WHEREAS, on January 15, 1998, the Commission adopted Resolution G-98-02 approving the 1998 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Fund Estimate, including expected revenues and expenditures for the Vincent Thomas Toll Bridge, and
- 1.2 WHEREAS, the Vincent Thomas Toll Bridge expenditure estimates as identified in the 1998 STIP Fund Estimate contained no major rehabilitation projects, but did anticipate reservations for minor-sized rehabilitation projects, including \$409,000 for Fiscal Year (FY) 1998-99 and \$100,000 per year for the remaining years of the 1998 STIP, and
- 1.3 WHEREAS, at the February 1999 CTC meeting, the Department of Transportation (Department) presented for Notice a Vincent Thomas Toll Bridge Program that shifted funding in the first two years of the program to include \$220,000 for FY 1998-99 to replace the existing headlight glare screen and an estimated \$190,000 for FY 1999-2000 for operational improvements, and
- 1.4 WHEREAS, the Department expects that \$100,000 per year will be adequate for the remaining years of the STIP.
- 2.1 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the California Transportation Commission hereby approves the Vincent Thomas Toll Bridge Program, including amendments by the Department at the Commission's February 1999 meeting, as reflected below.
