**CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION
Adoption of STIP Guidelines**

**RESOLUTION G-99-24
Replacing Resolutions G-98-01 and G-99-03**

- 1.1 WHEREAS in accordance with Section 14530.1 of the Government Code, the California Department of Transportation (Department), in cooperation with regional agencies, county commissions, local agencies, and Commission staff developed guidelines for the development of the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and incorporation of projects into the STIP, and
- 1.2 WHEREAS the Department submitted the proposed guidelines to the Commission on February 1, 1999, and
- 1.3 WHEREAS the Commission conducted a public hearing on the proposed guidelines in southern California on June 7, 1999 and a second public hearing on the proposed guidelines in northern California on July 15, 1999, and
- 1.4 WHEREAS the proposed guidelines are a complete and full statement of the policy, standards, and criteria the Commission intends to use in programming and funding projects in the STIP, and
- 1.5 WHEREAS in accordance with section 14530.1 of the Government Code, the Commission is required to adopt STIP guidelines,
- 2.1 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the California Transportation Commission does hereby adopt the STIP guidelines as proposed, including 1999-2000 Budget Act language related to California Transportation Planning Directions Statement, and subject to correction of several typographical errors, and
- 2.2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the adopted STIP guidelines shall supersede the 1998 STIP interim guidelines as amended by CTC resolution #G-99-05, and
- 2.3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Commission requests the Department, in cooperation with the Commission staff, to distribute copies of the adopted STIP guidelines to regional agencies, county transportation commissions and representatives of local agencies and transit agencies.
