The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments' (AMBAG) 2008/09 - 2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

20	Financial Element <ul style="list-style-type: none">The amendment updates the FTIP financial plan to include estimated revenue for the AMBAG region based on the proposed Jobs for Main Street Act of 2010. The amendment adds \$31,180,000 in the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds as revenue in the Fiscal Year 2009/10.
	Local Element <ul style="list-style-type: none">The amendment modifies various projects in the AMBAG region. These projects are funded from the High Priority Projects Program, Highway Safety Improvement Program, Highway Bridge Program, American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, and the proposed Jobs for Main Street Act of 2010.

The updated programming is for projects in air quality attainment area that is exempt from the conformity determination requirement. The AMBAG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that the amendment is financially constrained, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures per 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450.

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Pursuant to the authority delegated to me, I approve AMBAG's Amendment No. 20. I also recommend that FHWA and the Federal Transit Administration approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2009 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding. Projects included in this FTIP amendment are submitted by AMBAG through the California Transportation Improvement Program System (CTIPS).
