Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Modification No. 41 to California's 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes minor modifications to the rural, non-MPO portion of the FSTIP. Modifications are made to the following projects:

- Sixth Street Resurfacing, Glenn County, CTIPS ID 130-0000-1913. Additional savings have been realized for this project. American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funds have been reduced by \$56,000, leaving a total of \$427,000 still programmed for this project. The savings have been applied to other projects.
- Planting and Landscaping Grouped Project Listing, CTIPS ID 230-0000-0296. ARRA funding for the Glenn County City of Willows landscaping project has been increased by \$30,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2009/10. The increase is funded with a portion of the ARRA savings from the Sixth Street resurfacing project.
- Preventative Maintenance Grouped Project Listing, CTIPS ID 230-0000-0269. A new location is added for Glenn County, Phase III Road 57 to the South City Limits. This location is funded with \$158,000 of ARRA funds as a result of savings from the Tehama Street resurfacing project and the Sixth Street resurfacing project.
- State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Emergency Repair Grouped Project Listing, CTIPS ID 230-0000-0029. A new Mendocino County project, EA 497711, is programmed in FY 2011/12 for \$3,140,000.

These changes are submitted as an administrative modification. The changes are within the quadrennial element; do not reflect a change in the design concept or scope of the project, or impact financial constraints. Funding is available for this modification. In

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addition, there are no projects in this Administrative Modification No. 41 that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration and/or Federal Transit Administration approval, this FSTIP modification has been amended into California's 2008/09-2011/12 FSTIP.
