Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Please accept for your review and approval Administrative Modification #24 to SACOG's 2009/12 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP). SACOG staff made the requested changes for the attached projects using the authority delegated to staff by the SACOG Board of Directors to process administrative modifications to the MTIP. The proposed changes will not impact SACOG's financial constraint or the region's air quality conformity.

Administrative Modification #24 makes minor revisions to two grouped projects within two grouped project listings. The first is the Davis Second Street Ped/Transit Improvements, and the second is the Road Rehab Stimulus – Latrobe Road project. In both cases we are increasing the Recovery Act programming. In the case of the first, project these are funds given to SACOG by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) as per the attached memorandum of understanding. In the second case, El Dorado County experienced a cost savings on its other Recovery Act Project.

I would appreciate your expeditious review and approval of the enclosed modification. Upon your approval, this modification will be effective immediately.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of understanding between the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) and the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) is entered into by the Executive Directors of the respective agencies.

The parties do agree as follows:

1. TRPA agrees to allow SACOG to make use of \$65,649.00 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Transportation Enhancement (ARRA TE) apportionment from its unobligated balance with no repayment requirement.
2. Apportionment and obligational authority adjustments will be made by the California Department of Transportation's Programming Branch and Local Programs Branch respectively to SACOG's and TRPA's apportionment balance and target obligational authority level to reflect the obligational authority in the associated fiscal years that are the subject of this agreement.
3. Amendments to this memorandum of understanding may be entered into by the Executive Directors of SACOG and TRPA. Such amendments shall be binding on the parties if signed by the Executive Directors of both agencies and shall be effective as of the date shown in the amendment unless other wise indicated.
