The back-up lists include all projects from those programs that have not received Construction Authorization as of March 31, 2010. Projects that received Construction Authorization on or before March 31 are not included on this list in order to maintain financial capacity for future projects.

As always, we encourage all local agencies with a programmed safety project to deliver the project as soon as possible. Even if a project is shown in an outer year, the agency will likely receive an 'authorization to proceed' with any phase of the project regardless of the year it is programmed for delivery. Caltrans' Division of Local Assistance staff will coordinate with the MPO to exercise the Expedited Project Selection Procedure (EPSP) for all agencies willing to advance a project.
