Please notify all MPO Coordinators to incorporate the attached Backup Listings for the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) into their 2015 FTIP. This file can also be downloaded at [http://www.dot.ca.gov/hq/LocalPrograms/HSIP/hsip-statewide-backuplists\\_2015.html](http://www.dot.ca.gov/hq/LocalPrograms/HSIP/hsip-statewide-backuplists_2015.html). Please note these HSIP backup listings now supersede the prior listings.

Below is some more information regarding these listings:

**1. The backup lists are for both the HSIP Program and the High Risk Rural Roads (HR3) Program.** *In the new federal surface transportation act, "Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century" (MAP-21), the HR3 Program is part of the HSIP (not a set-aside as it was previously). However, since HR3 projects still need to be tracked separately from the other HSIP projects, there is a column in these listings to identify the HR3 eligibility.*

**2. All prior HSIP and HR3 projects that authorized the Construction Phase as of 9/30/13 are NOT included in the listings;**

*The original 2015 FTIP backup lists for the HSIP were based on projects' status as of 6/3/14. Many of these projects authorized construction prior to the beginning of the 2015 federal fiscal year – allowing them to be removed from the 2015 FTIP backup lists.*

**3. If desired, MPOs can request the draft copy of these backup lists which include special fonts and shading to allow MPOs to easily identify any and all changes from the list our office provided back on 6/3/2014.**

Even though all of these projects are shown to be programmed in specific FFYs (14/15, 15/16, 16/17, and 17/18), we expect most agencies will use Expedited Project Selection Procedures (EPSP) to deliver one or more phases of their projects in advance of the year it is programmed.
