Please note that not all MPOs have changes; however, he asks that you review the list for your respective regions to ensure that there are no discrepancies with the information provided.

These projects can be programmed through grouped project listings in the FTIP. For areas classified as air quality attainment, projects that can be classified as "Categorical Exclusion (CE)" per 23 CFR 771.117 (c) and (d) can be grouped together by CE classifications.

Subject New Lump Sum Backup Listings HSIP, HRRR and SRTS programs


Hello Lima.

The Division of Local Assistance, Office of Bridge and Safety Programs has implemented our internal process improvements which now allow us to efficiently prepare Lump Sum Backup Listings for Grouped Projects in the three Federal Safety Programs (HSIP, HRRR and SRTS) that we manage statewide. Using this new process, our office has prepared new Lump Sum Backup Listings for all MPOs with HSIP, HRRR and SRTS projects. These listings are now available on the Local Assistance website at: http://www.dot.ca.gov/hq/LocalPrograms/HSIP/FTIP_Info.html These new backup listings include all projects that should currently be in each MPO's FTIP and they identify all projects that have programming changes since the last FTIP backup list update.

The attached document shows all MPO's that have projects which need to be modified in the FTIP. *(Some of these projects may have already been modified by the MPOs, so they should compare their current list before initiating any changes.)*

Even though not all MPOs have projects needing FTIP modifications at this time , we recommend that all MPO's review these new listings and confirm they're in agreement. Any discrepancies need to be resolved.

From this point forward when programming changes are needed for one or more safety projects in these programs, the corresponding MPO backup listing will be replaced and posted on the above website. Our office will notify your office that an updated listing is available for the MPO's use.

We are confident that this change will reduce confusion and processing time for FTIP modifications and amendments.
