
The note below from Ted Davini, Caltrans Division of Local Assistance, provides information on the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). This information is to be used for developing your 2015 FTIP. If your draft 2015 FTIP is out for public review at the moment, then program the projects from your region through the first amendment to your 2015 FTIP. Note that the current 2013 FTIP is not required to reflect the new listing.

Use the fund type below when programming the projects in your 2015 FTIP. HSIP projects require 10% non federal match. Any local funding shown in the listings shall be programmed in the fiscal year in which the federal funding is programmed. Note that these projects can be programmed through grouped project listings in the FTIP. See links below for additional information.
