With this letter, I am transmitting the following amendment to the California's 2004/05-2006/07 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) for your approval. This amendment includes programming modifications to the rural, non-Metropolitan Planning Organization portion of the State and applies specifically to any or all of the twenty-one rural air quality attainment counties.

15	<p>Local Element</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The amendment modifies funding for the “Recreational Trails Lump Sum Project (MPO ID: VAR09)” by programming the Foothill Trail Bridge Replacement project in Humboldt County. The amendment revises total programmed funding to \$260,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2005/06. See enclosure. <p>State Element</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Modifies funding for one State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) project in Humboldt County. The amendment programs \$2,049,000 for Right of Way costs in FY 2005/06 for “Route 101/36 Interchange near Fortuna at Route 36 junction” to construct an interchange and frontage roads.

The updated programming is for projects in air quality attainment areas that are exempt from the conformity determination requirement. The financial impacts of this amendment are compatible with anticipated revenues in the FSTIP Financial Plan and do not significantly affect the overall financial analysis.

These projects are included and submitted by Caltrans through the California Transportation Improvement Program System (CTIPS).

The current wooden bridge will be replaced with a longer lasting steel I beam supported bridge and will be aesthetically designed to blend in with the environment by using native redwood for decking and handrails.
