The San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG) Board adopted Amendment No. 3 to the 2004 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) June 8, 2005. Included with this correspondence are the Authorizing Resolution, Public Hearing Notice, Financially Constrained Funding Tables, and the 2004 Project Fact Sheets for Amendment No. 3. Amendment No. 3 is available on the California Transportation Improvement Program System (CTIPS). On June 2, 2005, SLOCOG approved two Administrative Amendments. Amendment No. 4 increased the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 funding for the San Luis Obispo Regional Transit Authority (SLORTA) for 2005/2006 from \$218,000 to \$227,000. Amendment No. 5 increased the local match for SLORTA for 2005/2006 from \$218,000 to \$227,000. Copies of the Project Fact Sheets are attached.

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-07**

**ADOPTING AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO THE  
2004 FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (FTIP)**

The following Resolution is now offered and read:

**WHEREAS**, the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the San Luis Obispo region; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 134(h)(1) of the Transportation Equity Act of the 21st Century (TEA 21) requires that the MPO adopt a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the area for which the MPO is designated in cooperation with State and local agencies including local transit operators; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing notice was advertised in a local newspaper having countywide distribution; and

**WHEREAS**, the amendment was made available, members of the public were given a reasonable opportunity to review the amendment, and a public hearing was held to present the amendment and take testimony from the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed amendment was reviewed by the Citizens Transportation Advisory Committee (CTAC), which includes citizen representatives appointed by member agencies and at-large appointees appointed by the SLOCOG Board, and the Technical Transportation Advisory Committee (TTAC), which includes technical and planning representatives from participating agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the projects included in the program are consistent with the adopted Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) and are financially constrained.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments does hereby adopt Amendment No. 3 to the 2004 FTIP amending the projects into the FTIP as shown in the following table:



The San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG) will hold a Public Hearing to receive public testimony on the Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) Amendment No. 3: Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5307 FY '05/06 Grants, respectively for Operating Assistance to the Cities of Paso Robles (\$254K), Atascadero (\$159K), the Regional Transit Authority (\$120K), and the County of San Luis Obispo (\$19K), and in Capital Fleet Replacement (\$52K) to the City of Atascadero. In the Central urban area, Operating Assistance (\$291K), Capital Assistance - Fleet replacement (\$154K for one Trolley and \$220K for one Coach) plus Capital Maintenance (\$140K) to the City of San Luis Obispo, and Capital Assistance - Americans with Disabilities Act dispatch equipment to the Regional Transit Authority (\$65K).
