Tulare County Association of Governments approves the following Amendment to the Federal Transportation Improvement Program. The following Amendment will be known as **Amendment No. 16** to the 2004 FTIP amending the **Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Program (CMAQ)**. **This is project request is for an administrative amendment. This amendment transfers funds from one City of Lindsay project to another.**

“The project(s) included in the FTIP by this amendment has/have been demonstrated to satisfy the requirements of 40 CFR 93.118 and 93.119 without a new regional emissions analysis in accordance with the provisions of 40 CFR 93.122(e)(2)(ii). Accordingly, the Project(s) has/have been included in the regional emissions analysis of the Regional Transportation plan’s regional emissions at the time of the transportation plan’s conformity determination, and that the design concept, scope, and implementation schedule of the project(s) is/are not significantly different from that described in the transportation plan. In addition, the funding or the project(s) will not delay the implementation of projects in the metropolitan transportation plan or FTIP.”

**Administrative Amendment No. 16**

**CMAQ Project fund transfer:**

**Transfer funds \$62,000 (\$54,000 CMAQ funds \$8,000 local) to TUL04-027 TUL04-032-City of Lindsay: CNG, ZEV & SULEV low emission (Purchase six (6) CNG vehicles, nine (9) ZEV vehicles, and four (4) SULEV hybrid vehicles.)** The programmed project total is \$303,000 was \$365,000 and is distributed as follows:

1. FY 04/05 Con \$171,000 (loc \$20,000, Fed \$151,000)
2. FY06/07 Con \$132,000 **was \$194,000** (loc \$15,000 **was \$23,000**, Fed \$117,000 **was \$171,000**)

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**Transfer funds \$6,000 (\$6,000 CMAQ funds) to TUL04-027 TUL04-012-City of Lindsay: Nine ZEV Electric vehicles (Purchase nine ZEV electric vehicles for the Lindsay Unified School District)** The programmed project total is \$73,000 **was \$79,000** and is distributed as follows:

1. FY06/07 Con \$73,000 **was \$79,000** (loc \$9,000, Fed \$64,000 **was \$70,000**)

**Increase funding \$68,000 (\$60,000 CMAQ funds) funds from TUL04-012 and TUL04-032) TUL04-027-City of Lindsay: 15 SULEV Hybrid vehicles (Purchase 15 SULEV Hybrid vehicles for Lindsay Public Safety police Department replace gasoline vehicles)** The programmed project total is \$488,000 **was \$420,000** and is distributed as follows:

1. FY06/07 Con \$488,000 **was \$420,000** (loc \$56,000 **was \$48,000**, Fed \$432,000 **was \$372,000**)
